

NCWAA 1A/DISTRICT 7 BI-DISTRICT VOLLEYBALL STANDARD OPERATION PROCEDURES

TOURNAMENT GENERAL INFORMATION:

DATE(S):	Saturday preceding the State Tournament (Saturday, November 5 th , 2011)		
NUMBER OF TEAMS:	Top 3 from the CTL standings and the Top 3 from the NEA		
SITE ROTATION:	2010 – Freeman (District 7) 2011 – Chelan (District 6)		
TOURNAMENT FORMAT:	Single-elimination first round; double-elimination 2 nd round. See bracket.		
TEAM(S) QUALIFYING TO STATE:	Three (3) Teams qualify for State. Winner of game #5 is the #1 seed to state and the loser of game #5 is the #2 seed to state. The winner of game #6 is the #3 seed to state.		
ADMISSION PRICES:	Single Match –	Adults	\$7.00
		Students/Seniors	\$5.00

ROSTERS:	Team will be limited to Fourteen (14) players in uniform, two (2) team managers (not in playing uniform), and coaches.		
AWARDS:	District 6 Team Champion Trophy will be awarded to the CTL team finishing in the highest place at the Bi-District Tournament.		

TOURNAMENT RULES:

RULES:	National Federation rules will be followed, as well as any WIAA volleyball guideline rules. The site manager will explain any ground rules.
GAMES COMMITTEE:	The Games Committee shall consist of the site manager and two participating coaches not involved in the dispute in question. Its duties shall be those identified by the National Federation and WIAA and any other duties deemed appropriate by the Meet Director. Decisions of the Games committee are final.

BALLS:	The host school will furnish the state approved game balls.
OFFICIALS:	The host District will arrange for local officials for each tournament. Two (2) WOA certified officials, and two (2) certified line judges (when possible) will be assigned to each match by the site manager.
SCOREKEEPERS:	Official scorekeepers will be provided by the tournament manager.
HOME TEAM:	The team on the bottom of the bracket will be the Home Team. Home teams will furnish a Libero Tracker, and only the Home Team Libero Tracker will be allowed to sit at the scorer's table.
LENGTH OF MATCH:	Each match shall be three out of five games (65.3.0). Scoring for these matches will reflect the rules governing scoring during the State Championships
REPORT FOR MATCH:	It is the coach's responsibility to see that the team is near the assigned playing court at least 15 minutes prior to the established match time.
WARM-UP:	Between matches all teams will be given a minimum of 30 minutes (including on-court warm-up) between the end of their previous match and the beginning of play in the next match. To allow movement from one gym to the other, that 30 minutes will begin as soon as both teams are settled in the gym they will be participating in. For the first two rounds warm-up time on the assigned court will be a minimum of 20 minutes. Suggested schedule is 8, 5, 5, and 2 minutes. After two rounds have been completed warm-up time will be reduced to 5, 5, and 2 minutes.
TEAM BENCH:	The team bench is limited to 14 players, 2 team managers (not in playing uniform), and coaches authorized by the school on the official registration form.
CROWD CONTROL:	Pep banners, confetti, signs, mascots, and mechanical or artificial noisemakers, including band instruments used as noisemakers are not permitted at any of the tournaments.
BANDS:	No bands are permitted at the tournament.
FINANCES:	Tournament managers will send all receipts and expenditures to the District 7 director within one week of the end of the tournament. When the final expenses and profit are calculated, the host District will send a check for half (1/2) of the profit to the visiting District each year.
RESULTS:	The qualifiers for the next level must be reported immediately following the completion of the tournament to the District 6 and 7 Directors and WIAA Office.
